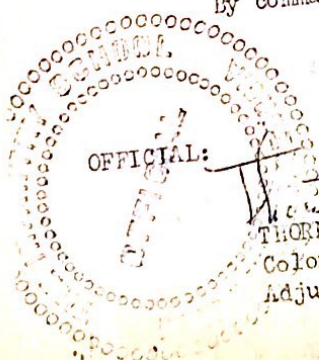

1st Lieutenant Lucien E. Consin, Inf, O-1322769.

Lieutenant Consin coming from Algiers parachuted into France 16 August 1944 as a member of the Jedburgh Team MARK, assigned to arm and assist the Maquis in the Gers Department, in guerrilla warfare against German garrisons and convoys.

On 19 August in its first participation in a Maquis attack on a convoy at Isle Jourdain the Team captured seven prisoners.

Shortly afterwards with the general evacuation by the Germans of southwestern France the work of the Team became largely that of intelligence and liaison including trips to the Spanish border to Agen and to Marseilles. The most important work, however, was done in the area of Royan where in conjunction with other Jedburgh Teams this Team worked to piece together the detailed plan of the German defenses. Arrangements also were made to pass on intelligence to a squadron of French planes that made twelve successful attacks on Royan.



 His mission consisted of organizing, training and leading French Resistance Groups and providing liaison for these groups.

Appraisals in theater: Completed mission in superior manner. Superior: Motivation, Practical Intelligence, Stability, Leadership, Physical Ability. Excellent: Ability to Work with Others. (Major Coxe)

Recommendations in theater: Further use in OSS: operational duty in the Far East. (Major Coxe)

Attitude towards OSS: Favorable. Complains that it is difficult to find out what the organization wants a man to do; also complains that OSS overlaps function with too many other organizations.

Desires as to future assignment: Operational duty in the Far East.

Evaluation: A voluble, energetic young man of French ancestry. He is a man of action - chiefly of independent action. Impetuous and sometimes rash, but dynamic and capable of inspiring men to follow his orders. He is resourceful in the field and a good organizer. High war motivation - he enjoys fighting. Practical intelligence superior. Social relations friendly and informal - he is an excellent conversationalist. His emotional stability is good in that he is likely to stand up well under stress. He lived away from his parents most of his life, though, and consequently was poorly disciplined and often reckless. This characteristic lack of conservatism continues, which makes him somewhat unreliable. Judgment not always good. Got involved in political matters in France somewhat beyond his depth.

Recommendation: Continuation with OSS: suitable for SO or OG operational duty in the Far East.

TO : Strategic Services Officer, OSS.

1. It is especially desired to commend the OSS units that were attached to or served in conjunction with this headquarters and those Chinese Armies and groups whose operations were coordinated through this headquarters with the Chinese Supreme Headquarters.

2. The varied and unusual type of duty performed by these units made their performance of duty most difficult. In spite of the belief of many foreigners, based upon ordinary news reports that the Chinese were finished guerilla fighters of long experience in such operations against the Japanese, there was actually little of this type of combat that had been carried on effectively for the past two years.

3. The arrival of aggressive and competent groups of officers, many with prior commando service in the European Theater, provided a great impetus to the Chinese. These young officers, with little or no prior service in China, were able to obtain the confidence of the Chinese entirely because of their military efficiency and ability to teach and produce results and to fight alongside of the Chinese in their units. The commando units overcame many difficulties and produced outstanding results during their service in China.

4. This headquarters has coordinated most of its work with these units through Colonel William R. Peers, Colonel William P. Davis, and Lt. Colonel Alfred T. Cox. All three of these officers have proven to be especially competent, cooperative, and outstanding for common sense and judgement. Because of their efforts, many of the difficulties which are inherent in coordinating military operations which are removed from the channel of military command have never even arisen.



1. Reference is made to AMZON Cable No. 313 and Washington No. 911, above subject.

2. In the overall planning for the reorganization of AMZON and the streamlining of Services personnel (as discussed by Mr. Lewis on his recent trip to Washington), it was decided to combine responsibilities of several Services Branch officers, thus automatically eliminating the position of Mess and Club Officer.

3. Original plans called for the recruitment of two junior officers from the United States, both of whom have indicated they are not interested in the assignment offered. In addition it has become an urgent necessity to immediately assign a junior officer to conducting and liaison duties out of the Office of Chief of Mission. Captain Conein has been assigned to this task in addition to his duties as Mess and Club Officer. The time spent on supervisory control of the messes and clubs has reached the point where it entails a total of only about four or five days per month. These duties are principally accountability both for supply and cash funds connected with the messes and clubs. The duties of the conducting and liaison officer are most peculiar in nature in that no set schedule of duties can be outlined at least with respect to time. There have been individual conducting assignments that involved a minimum of a few hours of a given day and other times such conducting assignment actually lasted two or three or more days. These assignments come up at unusual times and it is imperative that we have available such junior officers to meet all demands made upon us when they actually arise. On the other hand, the essential mess and club duties may be very well "sandwiched in" between the more important duties of the conducting officer.

4. There has been some discussion as to the unreliability of subject officer for reasons unknown to the writer. While it is perhaps true that during the war no one ever took a dim view of free wheeling operations, sufficient time has indicated by daily observation both on duty and in social activities that

1. Reference is made to your requisition dated 4 June 1946, requesting a Liaison and Conducting Officer for Amzon. Such request was made by Lieutenant Colonel Kubler, Executive Officer. Further reference is made to correspondence from Colonel Kubler dated 19 June 1946, under which he suggests that Captain Lucien Conein presently assigned as Mess and Club Officer, be detailed to fill the above request.

2. Captain Conein was reassigned to Amzon at the insistence of high echelon War Department authorities. When serving his first tour of duty in ETO, Captain Conein became involved with the daughter of the editor of one of the leading De Gaullist publications. The matter apparently was a serious one for when Captain Conein was returned to the United States, French officials contacted United States Government authorities in Washington, calling to their attention the relationship which had previously existed between Captain Conein and the aforementioned girl. Because of this situation, SSU was directed to return Captain Conein in an innocuous position to ETO for the purposes of settling his personal affairs with the aforementioned girl.

3. The suggestion of Colonel Kubler that Captain Conein be used as Liaison and Conducting Officer has been thoroughly discussed in Personnel Branch and with Security Branch. It is their unanimous opinion that the choice of Captain Conein to fill this requisition would be unwise. Because of his past history of personal relationships with high French officials, and because of the fact that Captain Conein is supposed to occupy an inconspicuous position, it is deemed advisable that he remain in his present position and not be transferred to a position where he might subject the organization to criticism and censure.
